Streak Ends at 32 Games

The Seminole AA's lost a hard-fought battle last Saturday to the Kentucky Wildcats 14-8. The loss ended the Seminoles 32-game win streak which dates back to the first grade.

The Wildcats took the ball on the game's opening drive and marched down the field 44 yards for a touchdown. The PAT was blocked by Daniel Silvestre.

The Seminoles came close to scoring twice in the first half, but couldn't punch it in.

In the second half, the Seminoles drove the length of the field to score the tying TD with just minutes remaining as Kyle Horton snuck it in from 1 yard out. Ray Martinez added an exciting PAT kick to take the lead 8-6.

However, on the ensuing kickoff, the Wildcats returned the kick for the go-ahead touchdown.

The defense did an awesome job holding the Wildcats to just one score. Marcus Rubalcava, Daniel Silvestre and Adrian Alcocer led the team in tackles with 6 each. DJ Rubalcava and Donnavan Manabanda each had 4 tackles.

The offense was able to mount several drives during the contest. Adrian Alcocer led the ground game with 34 yards in 8 carries. Marcus Rubalcava picked up 32 yards. Daniel Silvestre completed a beautiful pass to Alcocer on a critical fourth down situation. Victor Rivera and Hayden Wideman each had 11 blocks, while Brandon D'Annunzio and Ian Beltran had 9 blocks.

The Seminoles hit the road again as they face a much-improved Miami team this Saturday at 11:30 in Arcadia.
