### 6-3 Internet Shopping



Yes, for some of you, it's your dream assignment! You will be asked to shop for the best price on certain items.

First, let's list the advantages and disadvantages of shopping for items over the Internet.

**Advantages:** The most obvious advantage is that it is very easy to find an item that you are looking for without driving all over town. It also easy to compare prices between stores for the best price. Another advantage is price. You can find great deals on the Internet as opposed to shopping at a mall or store. Online stores can afford to charge less because they don't have to pay money for a store front, sales people, etc.

**Disadvantages:** The disadvantages include having to wait for your merchandise, having to submit your credit card number (which by the way is safer than using it at a store), and having to pay shipping charges. In fact, many companies will charge an excessive fee for shipping which will push the cost of the item over the amount you would have paid had you gone to a local store. There are also some companies that just charge more.
