Tips on Internet Searching

1. Start at **www.google.com** (type this address in the address window and hit enter). In the search window that will appear, type in keywords related to what you are looking for. If you want to find a document about Cocker Spaniels, type 'Cocker Spaniels'. You could narrow your search even further by adding more keywords. If you wanted to find information on purple cocker spaniels, add the word 'purple' to your list of keywords (however, there may not be any info on purple ones).

2. When you hit 'Search' or 'Go', a list of hyperlinked documents will appear. The ones that match your search criteria will be listed at the top. Click on a hyperlink that you think might be what your looking for.

3. Other popular search engines are **www.yahoo.com**, **www.hotbot.com**, **www.nlsearch.com**, **www.altavista.com**, and **www.lycos.com**. You can also try a metasearch site. A meta search site will look up your keywords in a number of different search engines at once. Try one at www.1blink.com or www.dogpile.com
