## **B Heels Hammer Falcons**

The Heels traveled out to Sierra Vista Park to play the falcons in back to back games. Devyn Cisneros executed a perfect onsides kick as Nick Cuda darted through the Falcons snatching the ball. The Heels marched down the field. Billy Hennessy shot down the sideline giving the Heels a huge first down. After a few more downs, Caden Thomas scooted around the end on a reverse, scoring for the second week in a row. The Falcons would stop Hernandez' PAT attempt and take over on downs.

The Falcons pushed hard into the Tar Heel defense, getting a first down on their first series. Billy Hennessy lead the team as line-backer with 5 huge tackles. Jake Hernandez downed 4 birds, Nick Cuda got 3, Seth Lynn and Devyn Cisneros wrapped up 2. Edward Silvestre, Caden Thomas, Evan Wilson, Juan Valesquez and Jacob Lyons each got 1. Devyn Cisneros would put an end to the Falcons attack as he plunged through the line and grabbed the ball right out of the quarterback's hands.

Robby Reyes and Steven Murguia punched a huge hole in the Falcon line, making room for Seth Lynn's 3 yard pickup, followed by Cuda with a 10 yard run. With 4th and about 6,

Devyn Cisneros swept around the right side of the field, bouncing off the Falcons and diving into the end-zone! This left the Falcons with time for only one more play in the half. Billy Hennessy came up hitting and tackled their runner to end the half.

The Heels would receive the ball to start the second half. Nathan Gonzalez ran for 10 yards on the day. Edward Silvestre picked up 12 yards and Josh Mora picked up 1 yard. Nick Cuda scrambled around the right side on a QB sweep for 10 yards and a touchdown. Okoye Saavedra put another point on the board finishing off with 7 yards on the day. The Falcons would try one final drive against the Heels. Evan Wilson came up big with a huge fumble recover, but the Falcons attacked him and regained possession. Eventually, the birds penetrated the Heels lines and scored.

## **C/B's Battle to the End**

The Heels swung into action against the Falcons as Fernando Morgan blazed a trail down the sideline on a 18 yard sweep around the left end and into the endzone. Moses Lujan kicked off for the Heels and Morgan pounced on the birds.

Fernando once again dominated the middle of the field with 7 tackles on the day. Jonathan Canchola followed with 5. Anton Edginton and

Aydan Cisneros muscled a bird out of bounds and Richard Arteaga blasted through the line. The Heels stopped the Falcons in their tracks and took over on downs.

Moses Lujan seemed to carry 8 boys on his back on his run up the middle. Jonathan Canchola picked up a couple yards followed by Jared Rosa with a 1 yard pickup. The Falcons, however, managed to stop the Heels this time.

Max Sanchez worked hard on defense picking up a big tackle, along with Noah Sandoval who pounded into the line. But the Falcons would eventually score a couple times, leading with a score of 6-12.

The Tar Heels weren't done yet. Once again Morgan took the payload across the goal line, this time from 20 yards out! Gavin Lovejoy's extra point attempt was good, giving the Heels the lead with a score of 13-12. With just seconds on the clock the Falcons mounted one last attack. After having their touchdown called back by a holding call, they managed to score with no time left on the clock. The Heels will travel to Arcadia to battle the Seminoles and to get back into a winning streak.
