Max Sanchez worked hard on defense picking up a big tackle, along with Noah Sandoval who pounded into the line. But the Falcons would eventually score a couple times, leading with a score of 6-12.

The Tar Heels weren't done yet. Once again Morgan took the payload across the goal line, this time from 20 yards out! Gavin Lovejoy's extra point attempt was good, giving the

Heels the lead with a score of 13-12. With just seconds on the clock the Falcons mounted one last attack. Quarterback, Julian Hernandez, did a play action fake and cruised around the right side to put 1 more point on the board.

Walker then blasted a 12 yard kickoff and Jose Durazo came flying in to down the Falcons. Durazo lead the team with 6 tackles on the day, followed by Collin Bergman-Gray with 5, Damian Pena with 4, Devin Ferguson and Justin Cruz each with 2, and Jessie Chavez and Vincent Sanchez had 1.

The Falcons would eventually score a couple times and move

ahead of the Heels with a score of 12-7. But the Heels weren't ready to back down yet! Jessie Chavez powered his way down the field with Derek Gonzalez lead blocking on a fullback blitz, picking up 10 yards, good enough for the first down. The Heels were spurred on by Damian Pena who stormed down the field on an amazing 15 yard run. Justin Cruz bolted pass the birds for a couple yards along with Collin Bergman-Gray.

The Heels were running out of options. With time running out and down by 5 points, they looked to the air for a prayer. Chavez launched the ball 15 yards and almost connected with Pena in the endzone, but the Falcons managed to break up the pass.
