## Saavedra Leads Offense, Ferguson Takes Control of Defense

Although the scoreboard didn't look much better this week, the Tar Heels came out ready to play this week. Okoye Saavedra returned the opening kickoff for 18 yards. Jessie Chavez found daylight, picking up 5 yards, followed by Saavedra with 2. Vincent Sanchez and Tyler McClure combined for another 2 yards, but not quite good enough for the first. The Wilddogs broke loose on the very next play on a QB sweep around our left side and into the endzone. Devin Ferguson denied their extra point attempt, crashing into their backfield. Ferguson continued to play well this game leading the defense with 5 huge tackles.

The Heels would then try to march down the field, but once again would be stopped by the Dogs. Seth Martin picked up 2 yards, Gavin Lovejoy had another 2 and Saavedra picked up 4. But the Dogs would hold the line on fourth down.

This time, however the Heels were ready! Okoye Saavedra and Abraham Almodovar combined on a sac on first down. Saavedra would then repeat on second and third down with help by Ryan Reyes and Andre Walker. Ferguson added to the assault on fourth and the Heels would reclaim possession of the ball. Sanchez would

sweep around the left side of the field for a couple yards as time expired.

The second half brought new life to the Heels as Ferguson blasted the opening kickoff right off the chest of a Wilddog and the Heels were able to recover! Jessie Chavez ran for 3 yards behind the blocking of Moses Lujan and Jerry Navarette. Sanchez grabbed a couple more yards behind Justin Cruz and Tyler McClure's side. McClure then swept around the left side for 3 yards but the Heels couldn't punch across the first down marker on fourth.

It was up to the defense to take over. Jessie Chavez, Jared Rosa and Abraham Almodovar sandwiched the runner on first down. Devin Ferguson blew a hole in their line and sacked the quarterback on second down. Third down was stopped by Noah Sandoval and Jessie Gutierrez. The Heels were looking good, but the Dogs managed to eventually break through the line, pulling ahead 12-0.

The Heels stopped the extra point attempt, but were running out of time. Jose Durazo picked up 3 yards on his attack, and Lovejoy had 5. The Dogs would hold the Heels at bay though and would eventually score another touchdown, ending the game with a score of 18-0.
