GREAT START TO A GREAT SEASON!

The Tar Heel B's swept into action early on in last Saturday's game against the Wildcats. The Heels executed a brilliant onside kick and Ivan Barragan came up with the recovery. Cole Sebert blasted up the middle for 3 yards, followed by AJ Salazar with a 17 yard dance to the 1 inch line. Barragan stormed the gates and punched it in for the Heels first touch-down of the season. Braydon Brus debuted his running game by completing the extra point conversion giving the Heels a 7-0 lead.

The cats came right back though and after three runs, were dancing into the endzone themselves. The Heels pounced on their extra point and would hold the Wildcats scoreless the rest of the game.

Brus returned the kickoff for 11 yards and the Heels bounced back into action. Ocean Saavedra picked up 4 yards on first down, followed by Jason Torres with a nice 5 yarder. Salazar found daylight up the middle on a QB keeper to get the first down. Salazar then connected with Brus on the next play for 6 more points from 10 yards out. Saavedra cruised around the left side untouched and added another point to the board.

Timmy Bass blasted a sweet 12 yarder on the kickoff and Barragan came up with the hit. The Heels defensive campaign flung into action with Nathan Alvarez, Timm Bass and Ivan Barragan leading the attack on the line. Linebacker, Brayden

Brus led the team with 4 tackles on the day. Defensive backs, Sebert and Saavedra contained the cat attack and safeties, Andon Wilson, Allan Pinedo, Ashton Ceballos and Aydan Cisneros all formed a protective barrier the Wildcats could not get through. The Heels held tight and eventually got the ball back with 47 seconds left in the half, but would end the half with a score of 14-6.

The Heels set to receive the second half. The kick found its way into Cole Sebert's hands. He was hit hard by a wall of cats, but Saavedra was there to pick up the ball. After a long series of penalties from both sides, the Heels looked to their blocking brigade to march down the field. Quarterback, AJ Salazar, stayed home in the pocket behind the blocking buddies of Skylar Davis, Canyon Smith, Timm Bass, Jason Torres and Xavier Gutierrez. Salazar delivered the payload into the ready hands of Barragan as he cruised down the field from 18 yards out. The extra point pass to Timm Bass was incomplete and the Heels would end the game with a score 20-6. This is a great start to a great season! Go Tar Heels!
