### **Stay True in All Circumstances**

*From 109 Forgotten American Heroes*

One of many forgotten heroes of the Underground Railroad was Calvin Fairbank. As a child, Calvin developed an early disgust with the practice of slavery. He listened to slaves tell their stories of hardship, and was convinced of the inherent evils of enslaving other people.

In 1837, he took action. While on a raft on the Ohio River, he spotted a black slave on the Virginia side of the river. He told the man to climb aboard and ferried him to the free land of the Ohio side of the river. This became Fairbank's life's work. In total, he helped free forty-seven men and women from bondage. He would retrieve them from southern states, disguise them, and smuggle them to Ohio, where other people would be waiting to bring them to safer destinations in the North, or in Canada. Like others who worked as part of the Underground Railroad, Fairbank had to keep his activities hidden. As a minister, he would occasionally preach or lecture on his anti-slavery views, but by and large his work was secret.

However, shortly after being ordained a Methodist elder, Fairbank was arrested and tried for freeing slaves. He was sentenced to 15 years in prison, of which he served four before being pardoned. In 1851, two years after he was released, he was kidnapped and sent to Kentucky, where he was tried again and sentenced to an additional 15 years in prison. This time he was in prison until 1864, 13 years later, before being pardoned. After he got out, Fairbank remained a critic of slavery. Before his death, he published an autobiography titled, *Rev. Calvin Fairbank During Slavery Times: How He "Fought the Good Fight" to Prepare "The Way,"* (not exactly a catchy title), which detailed his efforts to free Southern slaves.

Unfortunately, Calvin earned very little from the book's publication and he died in poverty in 1898 in New York. Usually the right course is not the easiest or most exciting. Popular and fun are rarely the adjectives used to describe the right path. Find your path and stick to it no matter how hard the winds blow.
