HEELS HAMMER WILDCATS

The Tar Heels maintained their undefeated season last Saturday, outscoring the Wildcats 26-13. The Heels opened up the game with a solid running attack. Abram Lugo, Mark Bowers and Mauricio Delgado combined for 18 yards on the first 3 carries. Andrew

Armas followed with a touchdown on a reverse, behind the Heels' big dog blocking force of Antonio Astorga, Josh Watkins, Elijah Perez and Thomas Valenzuela. After holding the Wildcats on 4 downs the Heels once again took over on offense. Isaiah Gallardo scored his first touchdown of the year after a huge drive by Decker DeGraaf, Abram Lugo and Maddox Lozano, giving the Heels a 12-0 lead. "Mad Maddox" then stormed through the Wildcat offensive line and sacked the quarter back on the next three downs! Marc Bowers, Aidan McClure and Maxwell Painter then finished off the series with a huge tackle on 4th and short. Byron Franco stepped into action offensively zig-zagging his way into the endzone for his first touchdown of the year! The half would end three plays later with a score of 20-0 as Bowers, Lozano and Lugo continued to hammer into the Wildcat backfield.

The Heels decided to open the second half with a little shotgun action, but after a loss of about 15 yards, quickly changed their strategy. Momentum then shifted in favor of the Wildcats who quickly scored a couple of touchdowns, bringing the score to 20-13. The Heels weren't done yet either, as David Avilez shot through the line. He cruised past the defenders and made it to the one foot line before he was caught from behind. Marc Bowers polished off Avilez's run with a quick 1 yard hop into the endzone ending the game with a score of 26-13. Congratulations on a well fought game. The Tar Heels have a bye this Saturday, but will return to action in next week's re-match against the Bulldogs in Arcadia.

Founding Member and President of Boys' Christian League and Kare Youth League
Passes Away at Age 95

In October 1931, Francis Ostergard was among the small group of young men who, with Orrick Hampton, founded the Boys' Christian League (BCL). The organization was later renamed Boys and Girls' Christian League and today is known as Kare Youth League (KYL). They wrote the Promise and Laws for the new club, which emphasize bravery, purity and truth – traits that would help children become successful adults and parents. The Promise and Laws remain unchanged today and are recited by members at all three of Kare Youth League's centers.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, October 13th at 7:00 p.m. in the Stivers Center at Kare Youth League, 5150 Farna Avenue, Arcadia.

Kare Youth League is currently developing a new sports complex for boys and girls in Irwindale where a ball field will be named in his memory.
