## ATTACKING THE CATS

The Tar Heels continued their undefeated season with a win over the Wildcats last Saturday. The Heels picked up over 70 yards on the day offensively and grabbed over 25 tackles accumulatively. A special shoutout goes to the Tar Heel blocking brigade comprised of Timothy Coble, Shane Irwin, Blake VanDeVeere, Samuel Rondero and Noah Penunuri who combined for over 30 blocks on the day.

Legend Lyons opened the game with a 15 yard KO return to bring the Heel offense into striking range. Jordan Moore bolted out of the backfield and scored on a huge 12 yard gain, which was unfortunately called back due to holding. But the Heels continued to fire at the endzone. Rondero picked up a couple yards followed by Moore with another 5 yards. Andrew Benavides then scored on a quarterback keeper, giving him 25 points on the year. The extra point attempt by Nathan Latcha was wide left though and the Heels would lead 6-0.

Latcha blasted a huge 20 yard kickoff and Lyons polished off the Wildcats. Jordan Moore then leaped into action, attacking the poor Wildcat offense. He picked up 3 quick quarterback sacks, but the Wildcats managed to find daylight on 4th and about 8 for a first down. They marched another 13 yards on their next run, only to be brought down by Lyons. Moore and Latcha combined on the next play pushing their offense back a couple of yards. The Wildcats would finally end their drive on an incomplete pass and the Heels took over on downs.

The Heels struggled to get things going on their next series, fumbling on first down, and getting another touchdown called back for holding on second. Lyons finally found some daylight around the left end on third and long, but fell short of a touchdown with no time left on the clock to end the half.

Max Martinez opened the second half with a 18 yard kickoff, followed by Benavides with a heart stopping tackle. The Wildcats battled back picking up a first down. Latcha and Jacob Reyes combined for a stop followed by Martinez and Rylan King with a huge hit. Nathan Ulloa and Cruz Soliz picked off a Wildcat runner along with Lyons, who lead the team with 9 tackles on the day.

Lyons then went down to score the final touchdown of the game, finishing it off with a score of 12-0 in favor of the the Tar Heels. The Heels will enjoy a much deserved week off, but will be back out on the field next Saturday in a rematch game against the Bulldogs. Congratulation boys!

February 23, 1918 – September 27, 2013

Founding Member and President of Boys' Christian League and Kare Youth League  
Passes Away at Age 95

In October 1931, Francis Ostergard was among the small group of young men who, with Orrick Hampton, founded the Boys' Christian League (BCL). The organization was later renamed Boys and Girls' Christian League and today is known as Kare Youth League (KYL). They wrote the Promise and Laws for the new club, which emphasize bravery, purity and truth – traits that would help children become successful adults and parents. The Promise and Laws remain unchanged today and are recited by members at all three of Kare Youth League's centers.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, October 13th at 7:00 p.m. in the Stivers Center at Kare Youth League, 5150 Farna Avenue, Arcadia.
