## TAR HEELS SOAR OVER THE FALCONS

The Tar Heels outscored the Falcons 26-21 in last Saturday's nail-biting action. The Falcons opened the game with a kickoff into the endzone. The Heels struggled to move the ball until Legend Lyons soared into action on 4th and about 4 to score on a 28 yard sweep around the left side. Lyons and Andrew Benavides then connected on the extra point field goal attempt to take the lead. But the Falcons stormed right back scoring just 4 plays later. Their extra point was good, but the Heels still led 8-7. Blake Van De Veere, Noah Penunuri and Rylan King picked up 5 combined yards, but Andrew Benavides would not be stopped. He scored on 4th and 5 on a huge 17 yard run behind the offensive wall of Timothy Coble, Jacob Reyes, Shane Irwin, Samuel Rondero and Nathan Latcha. The Heels

failed to score their extra point, however, and within 3 plays the Falcons once again scored ending the half 14-14. Jordan Moore opened the second half dominating both the offense and defense. He picked up 2 quick QB sacks on defense and then ran for 20 yards as tailback into the endzone to give the Heels a 20-14 lead. The Falcons were quick to answer though, scoring on the next kickoff. Their extra point was good, giving them their first lead of the game at 21-20. But the "Legend" continued to answer, scoring on the next kickoff to make the score 26-21. With just 2 minutes on the clock, the Falcons picked up a first down and marched another 9 yards down field, but this time could not penetrate the Tar Heels tenacious defense. Andrew Benavides, Nathan Latcha, Legend Lyons, Max Martinez, Jordan Moore, Noah Penunuri and Nathan Ulloa combined for 25 tackles on the day. Congratulations on a game well played! This week the Tar Heels will face the Kentucky Wildcats from Arcadia at 12:15 in Covina, followed by an exhibition game against the Bulldogs at 6:40 in Kare's Showcase at San Dimas High School.
