TAR HEELS WIN IN ANOTHER NAIL BITER!

Those Tar Heel boys sure like to make things close! The Heels battled the Wildcats in another epic battle to victory. The Heels combined for 28 tackles on the day with over 75 rushing yards and three touchdowns for 18 points. Their defense was spearheaded by Legend



Lyons with 8 tackles along with Jordan Moore with 5. Noah Penunuri, Erik Hernandez, Andrew Benavidez, Gunner Killam and Nathan Ulloa also added to the Tar Heels tenacious defense with 3

tackles a piece.

Nathan Ulloa opened the game for the Heels with a huge 28 yard touchdown, but it was called back on a holding penalty. Penunuri picked up 8 yards on his carry followed by Andrew Benavidez who picked up the first. Legend Lyons finished the attack with a 15 yard sweep into the endzone to give the Heels a 6-0 lead. The Tar Heels failed to complete any extra points though, keeping the Wildcats within striking distance the whole game. The Wildcats quickly answered with a touchdown of their own, but Noah Penunuri and Erik Hernandez came up with a big stop on the extra point attempt.

Dylan Rabins and Jordan Moore started off the next series with 6 and 4 yard carries respectively behind the blocking brigade of Erik Hernandez, Timothy Coble, Samuel Rondero, Nathan Latcha and Dylan Rabins. Unfortunately the Heels



fumbled on their next play and the Wildcats took over on downs. But the Wildcats returned the favor, fumbling on their attack as Legend Lyons did a 30 yard "scoop and score" to give the Heels a six point lead.

The Wildcats started the second half with a slow drive down the field. Ulloa, Hernandez and Moore made

some huge hits on the drive, but after eight plays the Wildcats eventually poked through the Tar Heel defense and tied the score. The Heels looked to Penunuri who stormed 8 yards down the field. Moore then sliced through their wall on another 8 yard carry. Benavidez polished off the



attack with a 25 yarder behind Matthew Wall's amazing block to give the Heels a lead of 18-12. The Wildcats had just about a minute left to try to score and came within 5 yards, but after a huge stop by Benavidez, Moore, Rylan King and Simon Rueff time ran out and the Heels would win another nail biter! Next Saturday the Heels play the Georgia Bulldogs in a night game in Arcadia. Go Tar Heels!!!
