Eventually the Dogs punched through the Heels' dynamic defense and put six points on the board.

The Heels had one more chance to score before the half. Rabins picked up 12 on a sweep falling just 3 yards short of the endzone. QB Benavidez quickly formed ranks and was able to spike the ball, stopping the clock. Penunuri then took control of the helm as quarterback and delivered a picture perfect pass to Simon Rueff, but it must have got lost in the lights as the half ended with a score of 13-6.

The Bulldogs came back quickly in the second half scoring on the kickoff and completing their extra point to tie the score. Tyler Garcia picked up a nice 5 yarder on the Heels next drive. Benavidez went for 7, Moore picked up a couple, Penunuri had 5 and the Heels looked to score, but were stopped just inches from scoring. The Bulldogs didn't get far on their series and the Heels would have one more chance to score with less than a minute left. Lyons, Moore and Benavidez pushed it 15 yards down field and once again the Heels spiked it to stop the clock. With just 11 seconds remaining the Heels turned to Noah Penunuri to finish the charge. But he was hit hard and the game ended in a 13-13 tie just 2 feet from the goal line. Congrats on an amazing game! The Heels will have a break next week to recover from this amazing game!
